Game

For this game you will need for each team: one small cup, one plastic water pitcher, and one small-mouth container such as a clean milk jug or vinegar container. The object of this game is to fill the small mouth container as full as possible in the time allotted. Each team member fills the cup, walks carefully to the small mouth container and carefully pours the liquid into the it. At the end of the time period, the leader will determine which team filled their container the fullest. You may wish to play this outside because of the possibility of spills, or you may substitute small beans or popcorn kernels if you are indoors.

Fill 'er up Relay



Craft

For this craft you will need baby food jars, beads, rocks or other small objects, and fine point permanent markers. Write each word from the bible verse on a bead or small object. Layer the objects with rice in the jar. Don't fill it up too full, you need to be able to shake it. When finished, replace the lid to the jar (you may wish to glue it or have an adult hot-glove it). You may vary the size of the beads or small objects according to the age of your class—larger objects for younger students, smaller objects for older students.

Bible Verse Shaker



Bible Skill

Use Bible Verse Shaker craft (above). Write each child's name on the shaker so it will return to them at the end of class. Have each child pass his/her shaker to the person on the right. Set a timer. At "GO," each child rotates the shaker to find each word of the bible verse. The first one to find the entire verse wins. Pass the shaker to the right at the end of each turn. NOTE: Please do this activity on a carpeted area so the shakers will bounce and not break!
