Group time: Box cars

- Locate several boxes and you can do this before class or have the children work on this in class. Decorate the outside of the boxes to look like cars. When they are complete you can have the children sit in them for group time. If you don't have enough for each child they can take turns or use them in a small group and have them travel to someone and tell that person about Jesus. Then that person can get in and "go" and tell someone else.

Painting with assorted vehicles:

You can use large pieces of paper or just regular size construction paper. Find vehicles that have different types of wheels so that they patterns will be different. The children will then "drive" the cars through the paint and then "drive" on the paper to see what the different patterns the vehicles make. They can also "drive" to someone's house and tell them about Jesus.

At the bottom of the page you can print or have them print Jesus loves you, or the Bible phrase for the day.



Vehicle Collage:

Find some die cuts of different vehicles (or if you are really good cut out vehicles shape free hand) Use just about anything to "decorate" the vehicles. Pom poms, feathers, sequins, other paper, craft sticks, pipe cleaners, etc. Let the children have fun covering and creating interesting vehicles.

At the bottom of the page or somewhere on the page write the Bible phrase or something about going and sharing about Jesus.



Love craft

As you can see from the picture the o and v in love are hands and feet. The children can use their finger to paint the L and the E. Depending on their age they can look at the letters and copy them or you can already have them on the page in pencil and they trace the letters.

You can add words like God Loves You, Jesus loves you, I love you, etc., or leave it just LOVE. The children can make two one to keep and one to give to someone.
