

Basic Play Dough Recipe

1 cup flour

2 teaspoons cream of tartar

1 tablespoons cooking oil

1/2 cup salt

1 cup water

Mix the flour, salt, and cream of tartar together.

Mix the cooking oil in the water and add to the

dry ingredients. Stir and pour mixture in an

electric skillet or nonstick pan. Stir constantly

until dough pulls away from the sides of skillet

or pan. This process takes about 3 minutes.

Empty dough onto waxed paper. Knead until

smooth and cool. Store in a zip-lock bag.

Snow Play Dough

To Basic Play Dough Recipe—

Add:

1 tablespoon white powdered tempera paint

Substitute:

1 tablespoon clear baby oil for cooking oil

Mix ingredients and prepare according to

directions for cooking and storing.

Daffodil Play Dough

To Basic Play Dough Recipe—

Add:

1 tablespoon yellow powdered tempera paint

Mix ingredients and prepare according to

directions for cooking and storing.

God made the flowers (Genesis 1:1)



Watermelon Play Dough

To Basic Play Dough Recipe—

Add to dry ingredients:

1 package Watermelon (Kiwi) Kool-Aid

Mix ingredients and prepare according to

directions for cooking and storing.

Note: Add food color during cooking process:

24 red/2 blue drops or red, as desired.

Pumpkin Pie Play Dough

To Basic Play Dough Recipe—

Add:

2 teaspoons pumpkin pie spice

Mix ingredients and prepare according to

directions for cooking and storing.

Note: Food colors for orange (15 yellow/5 red

drops) can be added during cooking process.

God sends the autumn rain (Jeremiah 5:24).



Peppermint Play Dough

To Basic Play Dough Recipe—

Add:

1 teaspoon peppermint flavoring

Mix ingredients and prepare according to

direction for cooking and storing.

Note: Green or red food colors can be added

during cooking process.
