Make a Wig-play a game

This craft will probably appeal to the younger children, but you never know, sixth graders may surprise you! Items needed: construction paper, scissors, stapler

Cut 2" strips of paper for headband. Wrap strips around child's head to determine fit. Staple the strips together. Use more construction paper (9" x 12" works best) and cut long strips, but leave one end intact. Staple the "hair" onto the headband. Now everyone wear their "hair" while you play a game: write words from the Bible story on index cards. Place the index cards face down in a pile. Take turns drawing a card (no peaking!) and placing it on your forehead with the word facing out. You must ask clues of the other class members to figure out the word you are holding to your forehead.





Rope Relay

For this game you will need one rope for each team. Tie knots spaced along the rope. You will need the same number of knots as you have kids on each team. At "GO!" each team member must untie one knot and pass the rope to the next team member. That team member will untie a knot, and so on. The first team to untie all knots wins.





Strong Man Relay

You need: one adult-sized long-sleeved t-shirt or thermal undershirt (stretchy is best) for each team, and 4 small inflated balloons for each team

Place the long sleeved t-shirt and four balloons for each team in front of their line. Each team member must pull the shirt over their clothes and insert two balloons in each sleeve's upper arm area to represent muscles. They then make "strong arms" and run to the other end of the room, touch, and run back. The player must then take off the shirt and muscles and the next player repeats.

Alternative: Have them shout the memory verse after they don their "muscles".
