



### Build a Card Tower

Items needed: Decks of cards, fabric tablecloth

Divide children into several teams. Place fabric tablecloths on tables so the cards won't slip on the table. Set a time limit (5-10 minutes). See which team can build the tallest tower. This requires teamwork, patience, sharing, and cool heads!



### Shoebox Diorama

Items needed: One shoebox for each child, construction paper, scissors, glue, pencils, or markers

Build a room to illustrate the Bible story. Draw and cut out a bed, table, chair, and lamp. Glue the objects inside the box to complete the room. The room shown also has a rug with the Bible verse written on it.



### "Stick Together" Race

Pair children. Each pair of kids should touch their adjoining feet together and attempt to walk from one side of the room to the other with their feet always touching. Their feet cannot lose contact with each other or they must start again. This is more difficult than it sounds!

For younger children you may want to use yarn or masking tape to make it easier to stay connected.
