

## Build The Water Wheel

### Build the Water Wheel:

- 1) Spray paint two matching hoola-hoops with glossy brown spray paint (paint for plastic).
- 2) Create paddles using card board fabric bolts from the local fabric store.
- 3) Stand six of the bolts as paddles to resemble the shape of an asterisks and tape together so it will not fall.
- 4) Lay the Hoola-Hoop on top of the paddles and secure it with a strip of brown duct tape and completely cover the edges of the bolt.
- 5) It should look like spokes on the wheel. Spray paint the paddles if desired.
- 6) Long strips of card board or old fence pickets in the shape of an upside down "V" can be attached to the sides to resemble a frame.
