



- Cardboard, construction paper
- Computer and printer to print the greeting
- Buttons
- Glue
- Thin bendy wire
- Ribbon
- Small nail for making hole

**Cute as a Button**

1. Cut out heart shapes from cardboard and construction paper.
1. Print the greeting from computer and cut the paper into a heart shape.
2. Assemble and glue the paper hearts together
3. Glue buttons around the heart.
4. Poke a small hole with a push pin into the top of the cardboard heart on both sides to hold the wire.
5. Bend wire through the holes and curl around a pencil.
6. Attach a ribbon to the wire.



**Monster Valentine Box**

- Empty tissue box (any size or hole type)
- Wrapping paper
- Tape, glue, scissors
- Large googly eyes
- Yarn, ribbon, fringe
- Construction paper

1. Look at your tissue box and its opening and decide how you want your monster to look.
2. Wrap the box in colorful wrapping paper, leaving the hole open.
3. Decorate the box with googly eyes, ribbon, construction paper, etc. to make your monster.
4. Valentines can be inserted into the monster's mouth.
