1- Pastoring your Class

The Bible never mentions volunteers.



Ephesians 4:11-12 (NASB)

"And He gave some as apostles, and some as prophets, and some as evangelists, and some as pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ;"

The "P" in pastor stands for presence. When Bro. Hance is out we miss him. We have a good sermon but it is not the same. This is true for the children you teach. Your presence is essential. Remember to:

- Arrive early to greet each child. Being noticed by the teacher communicates acceptance and sets the tone for how the class time will go.
- Be prepared so you can engage with the kids rather than looking for things and being disconnected. Kids' behavior will be easier to guide with a teacher who gives his/her complete attention.
- Let your personality show in the classroom. Just like you make your house a home, make your classroom personal too. Prepare bulletin boards; organize furniture and cabinets that reflect your preferences and personality. Kids feel closer to you just being in your classroom. Visit with other teacher's sharing the classroom so you can identify the things you share and your plan to improve the classroom space.
- Remember to send cards to kids and let them know you are thinking of them. Being present in their life even when you are apart is a part of pastoring your class.
