Sample Bible Drill

Book Drill

We will now have the Book Drill. I will call a book of the Bible. After the call "Start" is given you will have 10 seconds to find any page in the book, place your index finger on the page, and step forward. If called on you will name the book preceding the book called, the book called, and the book following the one called. The first call will be a practice call and will not be scored.

Attention. Present Bibles. Exodus. Start.

Practice: "Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus."

Attention. Present Bibles. Hebrews. Start.

#1 **"Philemon, Hebrews, James."**

Attention. Present Bibles. 1 Corinthians. Start.

#2 **"Romans, 1 Corinthians, 2 Corinthians."**

Attention. Present Bibles. Mark. Start.

#3 **"Matthew, Mark, Luke."**

Attention. Present Bibles. Isaiah. Start.

#4 **"Song of Solomon, Isaiah, Jeremiah."**

Attention. Present Bibles. Deuteronomy. Start.

#5 **"Numbers, Deuteronomy, Joshua."**

Attention. Present Bibles. Psalms. Start.

#6 **"Job, Psalms, Proverbs,"**

Extra Call: Attention. Present Bibles. Leviticus. Start.

"Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers."

Key Passage Drill

We will now have the Key Passage Drill. I will call the title of a Key Passage. After the call "Start" is given you will have 10 seconds to find any portion of the passage, place your index finger on the passage, and step forward. If called on you will state the title of the Key Passage and the reference. You will be asked to read a verse contained in the passage. The first call will be a practice call and will not be scored.

Attention. Present Bibles. The Parable of the Sower. Start.

Practice: "The Parable of the Sower: Mark 4:1-20."

Please read verse 9

Then He said, "Anyone who has ears to hear should listen!"

- #7 Attention. Present Bibles. A Psalm of Praise. Start.
"A Psalm of Praise: Psalm 100."
Please read verse 4
"Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise. Give thanks to Him and praise His name"
- #8 Attention. Present Bibles. The Temptation of Jesus. Start.
"The Temptation of Jesus: Matthew 4:1-11."
Please read verse 1.
"Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the Devil."
- #9 Attention. Present Bibles. The First Lord's Supper. Start.
"The First Lord's Supper: Luke 22:15-20."
Please read verse 19.
"And He took bread, gave thanks, broke it, gave it to them, and said, "This is My body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of Me."
- #10 Attention. Present Bibles. Jesus and Nicodemus. Start.
"Jesus and Nicodemus: John 3:1-21."
Please read verse 3.
"Jesus replied, "I assure you: Unless someone is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."
- #11 Attention. Present Bibles. The Faith Chapter. Start.
"The Faith Chapter: Hebrews 11."
Please read verse 1.
"Now faith is the reality of what is hoped for, the proof of what is not seen."
- #12 Attention. Present Bibles. The Greatness of God. Start.
"The Greatness of God: Isaiah 40."
Please read verse 29.
"He gives strength to the weary and strengthens the powerless."

Extra call:

Attention. Present Bibles. The Crucifixion. Start.
"The Crucifixion: John 19"
Please read verse 2.
"The soldiers also twisted together a crown of thorns, put it on His head, and threw a purple robe around Him."

Completion Drill

We will now have the Completion Drill. I will quote a part of the verse. If you can complete the verse and the reference, step forward. The first call will be a practice call and will not be scored.

Attention. In the Beginning Start.

Practice: *In the Beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Genesis 1:1*

#13 Attention. The LORD is good, Start.
“The LORD is good, a stronghold in a day of distress; He cares for those who take refuge in Him. Nahum 1:7”

#14 Attention. In this regard, Start.
“In this regard, it is expected of managers that each one of them be found faithful. 1 Corinthians 4:2”

#15 Attention. For a child will be born for us Start.
“For a child will be born for us, a son will be given to us, and the government will be on His shoulders. He will be named Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. Isaiah 9:6”

#16 Attention. And be kind and compassionate to one another Start.
“And be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving one another, just as God also forgave you in Christ. Ephesians 4:32”

#17 Attention. The grass withers Start.
“The grass withers, the flowers fade, but the word of our God remains forever.” *Isaiah 40:8*”

#18 Attention. We know that all things work together for the good Start.
“We know that all things work together for the good of those who love God: those who are called according to His purpose. Romans 8:28”

Quotation Drill

We will now have the quotation calls. I will give you the reference to a verse. If you know the verse, step forward, prepared to give the verse and the reference. The first call will be a practice call and will not be scored.

Attention. Luke 6:37 Start.

Practice: ***“Do not judge, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven. Luke 6:37”***

Attention Acts 16:31 Start.

#19 ***“So they said, “Believe on the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved- you and your household Acts 16:31”***

Attention. John 15:12. Start.

#20 ***This is My command: love one another as I have loved you. John 15:12***

Attention. Luke 11:9. Start.

#21 ***“So I say to you, keep asking and it will be given to you. Keep searching, and you will find. Keep knocking, and the door will be opened to you. Luke 11:9”***

Attention. Proverbs 3:5-6 Start.

#22 ***“Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not rely on your own understanding; think about Him in all your ways, and He will guide you on the right paths. Proverbs 3:5-6”***

Attention. Matthew 5:16 Start.

#23 ***“In the same way, let your light shine before men, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven. Matthew 5:16 “***

Attention. Psalm 118:24 Start.

#24 ***“This is the day the LORD has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it. Psalms 118:24”***
